



The seventh principle of ICA Statement: "Concern for Community"

The seventh principles of ICA Statement on the Cooperative Identity viz., "Concern for Community" is the real challenge for the all types of cooperatives. The questions:

Can we do something for the problems of youth which is integral to the community concerns?

Is it not time that we address issues like education and poverty?



1-2 Network of Co-operatives

The issue of contributing to the community calls for a NETWORK OF COOPERATIVES. As a part of this network the university cooperatives may attend to the problem of education. If it is true that "education helps ease the problem of poverty", the cooperatives will have to show concern towards this crucial issue. The emphasis therefore, is that there is a need for cooperation among cooperatives not only in the economic front but in the cultural front as well.

The belief of this proposal on HRD of Youth through cooperatives is that "participation in vital issues of Community makes consumer coops more acceptable to the people and enhances its social image."






